Oil and Gas Ordinance - BT motioned to reject the proposed ordinance as submitted because it was felt that as written the ordinance would be unenforceable and would be in conflict with the state law. Three votes were cast in favor of the motion with LC abstaining since he was involved with the writing of the proposed ordinance.

BT motioned that the Planning Commission recommend to the Supervisors that any proposed rewrite of the Zoning Ordinance should be handled by Planning Commission with input from the residents. Three votes were cast in favor of the motion with LC abstaining.
