

**MT. PLEASANT TWP. BOARD OF SUPERVISORS' SPECIAL MEETING OF JULY 30, 2014**

The special meeting of July 30, 2014, was called to order at 6:04 p.m. by Chairman Smith with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag. Those present were: R. Bryan Smith, Chairman (BS), Gary R. Farner, Vice-Chairman (GF), Dencil Backus, Supervisor (DB), Neva L. Stanger, Solicitor (NS), Mary Ann Stevenson, Secretary (MS), and those citizens listed on the attached sheet.

**Purpose:** To consider allocation requests for Act 13 revenue.

**Public Comments and Requests for the Allocation of Act 13 Revenue:**

1. Rebecca Skirpan representing the Heritage Public Library requested \$4,960 for a new copier/fax machine.
2. Paul Battista, Chairman of the Municipal Authority asked for all of the money to be set aside for the purpose of developing a public sewage system. He also asked for 75% of future Act 13 revenue for the next 10 years or until public sewage is in place and paid for.
3. Jeff Donati supports a public sewage project.
4. Priscilla Bernard supports a public sewage project.
5. Kevin Dry asked for \$100,000 per year for the next 5 years for a new fire / rescue engine.
6. John Bershok supports a public sewage project. He suggested additional money for the police department.
7. Jane Worthington requested public water and restrooms for the ball field at the Community Center. She estimated approximately \$25,000.
8. Chief Louis McQuillan requested additional man power; a new stand-alone building or an addition to the current building; training for the officers; tablets for the cars; new vehicle and patrol rifles for the cars.
9. Don Reed supports a public sewage project.
10. Paul Battista suggested the Corwin Building as a new police office due to having room across the street to pull trucks over.
11. John Bershok suggested cameras for the police cars.
12. Mary Ann Stevenson requested additional money to finish the comprehensive plan and that money be set aside for a new township building.

**Deliberations:**

There were no deliberations. The Supervisors are taking these requests into consideration.

**Adjournment:** DB motioned to adjourn the meeting at 6:55 pm and GF seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.
