

**MT. PLEASANT TWP. BOARD OF SUPERVISORS**  
**SPECIAL MEETING OF MAY 9, 2016**

CALL TO ORDER                   The Special Meeting of May 9, 2016, was called to order at 8:04 a.m. by Chairman Farner with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag. Those present were: Gary Farner, Chairman, Brian Temple, Vice Chairman, Don Reed, Supervisor, and Erin Sakalik, Manager

PUBLIC DISCUSSION               The Chairman asked if anyone cared to speak on agenda items. No discussion ensued.

PURCHASE LOADER               Brian explained that it has been a challenge to locate a loader to rent. The loader that the Cross Creek group looked at in Erie was in worse shape than the loader that is being considered today. Discussion ensued.

  Brian then suggested that we have the ability with this purchase to rent out the loader at the standard PennDot rate with a written agreement.

  Temple made a motion to purchase the 1999 Athey loader at a cost of \$18,000 and \$300 for hauling at a total of \$18,300 to be paid from the Local Share account.

PURCHASE KUBOTA               Farner made a motion to purchase a canopy for the Kubota tractor at a price of CANOPY                               \$502. Reed seconded the motion. Motion carried.

OTHER BUSINESS                 Southview Park. Don inquired about the location of the playground equipment at Southview Park. His concern was about the septic.

  Sale of police car and tractor. Brian conveyed that there was a vote a few months ago to sell the old police car and tractor. Erin suggested selling them on MunciBid. Brian made a motion to list both on MunciBid. Don seconded the motion. Motion carried. The brush hog will be sold with the tractor.

  Trees on Rt. 18. Don stated that he spoke with Mr. Bongiorno about his pine trees. Mr. Bongiorno has agreed to let the township trim them.

  Dollar General. Don next brought concern about the sight obstruction pulling out of Dollar General on Rt. 50. Erin said that she will contact PennDot.

PUBLIC DISCUSSION               Ron Moore conveyed concern about Caldwell and Rt. 18 on Bedillion's property.

ADJOURNMENT                    The meeting was adjourned at 8:19 a.m.
