► LG motioned to accept the reports as given and AM seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Action Items:

1. **Bills:** AM motioned to authorize the payment of the invoices for the period of 2/27/13 – 3/26/13 as presented and LG seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.
2. **Minutes:** LG motioned to adopt the minutes of the February 27, 2013 regular board meeting and AM seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.
3. **Full Time Police Officer:** AM motioned to offer part time Police Officer Brad Resnick a full time position effective as soon as possible as per the rate and benefit schedule outlined in the Collective Bargaining Agreement. LG stated that through extensive testing Officer Resnick scored very high. LG seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.
4. **Part Time Police Officer:** AM motioned to offer a part time Police Officer position to Amanda Brewer effective as soon as possible as per the Collective Bargaining Agreement. AM added that she also scored high on the tests and would be an asset to the department. LG seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.
5. **Community Center Request:** LG motioned to approve a request from the Community Center to repair the roof at a cost of \$5,652 to be performed by Centimark Corp. and AM seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously. LG stated that this amount will be paid by the Community Center not the Township.
