RESOLUTION # 2014 – S

A RESOLUTION OF MOUNT PLEASANT TOWNSHIP, WASHINGTON COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ADOPTING DIRECTION TO THE WASHINGTON COUNTY SEWAGE COUNCIL FOR THE ADMINISTRATION OF COMPLAINTS REGARDING ON-LOT SEWAGE SYSTEMS WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT PLEASANT.

WHEREAS, the Township Board of Supervisors entered into an Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement (the “Agreement”) with the Washington County Sewage Council (“WCSC”); and

WHEREAS, the Township Board of Supervisors has by the Agreement delegated the authority for sewage inspections and enforcement of on-lot sewage disposal systems to WCSC; and

WHEREAS, the Township and the Municipal Authority are in the process of designing, funding and constructing a public sewage system within the Township, which said system is a multi-phase, multi-year, project, the purpose of which is, in part, to address the failing on-lot sewage systems throughout the Township; and

WHEREAS, the Township Board of Supervisors by this Resolution desires to expand upon and clarify the WCSC process for investigating complaints regarding the function of on-lot sewage disposal systems.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED the Township Board of Supervisors of Mount Pleasant, incorporates the above recitals into this resolution, approving, by adoption of and for the reasons stated in the Resolution, as follows:

Section 1. When receiving a complaint from a Mount Pleasant Township resident regarding the function of an adjacent or neighboring on-lot sewage disposal system, the function of the on-lot sewage disposal system of the complaining resident also will be inspected.

Section 2. All Mount Pleasant Township Residents who submit a complaint about an on-lot sewage disposal system will be given a summary of the current status of the Municipal Authority’s sewage project, and a summary of costs, fines and penalties, as prepared by the Township Zoning Officer in cooperation with the Municipal Authority.

This Resolution adopting “WCSC process for investigating complaints” was enacted by the Township Board of Supervisors this the 24th day of September 2014, a quorum being present and the majority of the quorum of the Board voting in favor thereof.
