**RESOLUTION # 2014 – T**

**A RESOLUTION OF MOUNT PLEASANT TOWNSHIP, WASHINGTON COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING THE DISTRIBUTION OF ACT 13 IMPACT FEE FUNDS.**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Act 13 of 2012, the Township of Mount Pleasant receives a yearly distribution of impact fees; and

**WHEREAS**, within the constraints of Act 13 the Township may use the impact fees for certain Township purposes; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors values and considers the public's input into the distribution of the Act 13 funds within the community and therefore held a special meeting on July 23, 2014 for the purpose of receiving public input on the use or uses of the distributed funds; and

**WHEREAS**, on August 27, 2014 the Board of Supervisors considered the public input and deliberated upon the distribution of the 2012-2014 Act 13 Impact Fees; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors desires to adopt by resolution the 2012-2014 distribution of the Act 13 Impact Fees.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** the Township Board of Supervisors of Mount Pleasant Township, incorporates the above recitals into this resolution, approving, the distribution of the 2012-2014 Act 13 Impact Fees as follows:

1. \$900,000.00 to the Mount Pleasant Township Municipal Authority for the purpose of the sewage project, with a pledge of a minimum of 50% of the yearly Act 13 allocation to the Mount Pleasant Municipal Authority for the sewage project for each of the next 5 years; provided however this pledge is only in effect so long as there are Act 13 funds distributed to the Township; and
2. \$25,000.00 to the Mount Pleasant Township Planning Commission for the purpose of the Township comprehensive plan; and
3. \$75,000.00 to the Mount Pleasant Volunteer Fire Department for the purpose of the purchase of a fire truck; and

4. \$75,000.00 to the Mount Pleasant Police Department for the purpose of equipment and a vehicle, the specifics of which must be approved by the Board of Supervisors; and
  
5. \$20,000.00 to the Mount Pleasant Township Parks & Recreation Department for the purpose of repairs and events, the specifics of which must be approved by the Board of Supervisors; and
  
6. \$234,601.00 to be deposited into the Township's capital reserve account.

This Resolution adopting the "2012-2014 Act 13 Impact Fee Distribution" was enacted by the Township Board of Supervisors this the 24<sup>th</sup> day of September 2014, a quorum being present and the majority of the quorum of the Board voting in favor thereof.
