Building/Zoning Permit Application Requirements For Residential Construction

1. Obtain sewage permit (new dwellings only) from the Washington County Sewage Council, 550 Washington Road, Washington Pa 15301. 724-223-0504. Website www.wcseptic.com. If a sewage permit is needed, it must be obtained before a building permit application can be considered.

2. Complete a Building Permit Application and attach the following:

3. Plat plan showing all property lines, including dimensions, and show distances from all property lines to:
 - All existing and proposed structures
 - On-lot sewage system (if applicable)
 - Well(s)

4. Proof of Worker's Compensation insurance for the company doing the construction.

5. Permit fee - Consult Current Fee Schedule.
 - Generally two separate checks will be needed. One payable to Mount Pleasant Township for the Building/Zoning Permit and the another payable to HMT and Associates Inc. for all required inspections. Verify inspection fee estimates with HMT.

6. Road encroachment permit.
 - For township road, acquire separately through the Township office.
 - For state road, acquire through Penn Dot – Phone 724-439-7228

Before any construction (digging) begins call Pennsylvania One Call 1-800-242-1776 to check for any underground gas, electric, telephone lines.

You may wish to check with the DEP, 25 Technology Drive, California Technology Park, Coal Center PA 15423, 724-769-1100 to locate any mines under the property.

Typically, a completed Building/Zoning application can be reviewed and permit issued when correctly submitted with all the required information. However, the Township reserves the right to thoroughly review the application and attachments. The permit will then be issued or denied within a reasonable time. Call the Mt. Pleasant Township Code Enforcement Officer with any questions or to assure the Officer will be available. Phone number is 724-356-7928.
