Washington County 2022 Hazard Vulnerability
Assessment and Mitigation Plan Update

WHEREAS, the Township of Mount Pleasant, Washington County, Pennsylvania is most vulnerable to natural hazards which may result in loss of life and property, economic hardship, and threats to public health and safety, and

WHEREAS, the Township of Mount Pleasant acknowledges the requirements of section 322 of DMA 2000 to have an approved Hazard Mitigation Plan as a prerequisite to receiving post-disaster Hazard Mitigation Grant Program Funds, and

WHEREAS, the Washington County 2022 Hazard Vulnerability Assessment and Mitigation Plan has been developed by the Washington County Department of Public Safety in cooperation with other county departments, and officials and citizens of the Township of Mount Pleasant, and

WHEREAS, a public involvement process consistent with the requirement of DMA 2000 was conducted to develop the Washington County 2022 Hazard Mitigation Plan, and

WHEREAS, the Washington County 2022 Hazard Vulnerability Assessment and Mitigation Plan recommends mitigation activities that will reduce losses of life and property affected by natural hazards that face the County and its municipal governments,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the governing body for the Township of Mount Pleasant

- The Washington County 2022 Hazard Vulnerability Assessment and Mitigation Plan is hereby adopted as the official Hazard Mitigation Plan of the Township of Mount Pleasant, and
- The respective officials and agencies identified in the implementation strategy of the Washington County 2022 Hazard Vulnerability Assessment and Mitigation Plan are hereby directed to implement the recommended activities assigned to them.


